4. **DISTRICT OF DOMICILE:-**

i) DOMICILE/PERMANENT RESIDENTIAL CERTIFICATE :-

Candidates must belong to following districts of Chhattisgarh of ST category.

- (a) Bijapur
- (b) Dantewada
- (c) Sukma
- (d) Narayanpur

ii) The candidates belonging to the above Districts will only be considered for recruitment on production of valid “Domicile Certificate” issued by competent authorities so authorised by the concerned State/District to prove their domiciliary status. In absence of domicile certificate, PRC(Permanent Residential Certificate) issued by the competent authority may also be accepted.

iii) The vacancies are to be filled up by the candidates only belonging to **Scheduled Tribe** of the above LWE affected Districts of State. The candidate belonging to that particular LWE District will only be considered for recruitment in their respective District on producing of valid “**Domicile Certificate/Permanent Residential Certificate**” issued by competent authorities so authorized by the concerned State/District to prove their domiciliary Status.

iv) No candidate hailing from other LWE districts will be allowed to participate in the rally.

v) **A candidate may appear in recruitment process from any of the above four districts. However, they will be considered against the vacancies of their original district after completion of recruitment process.**

5. PAY AND ALLOWANCES AND OTHER FACILITIES

Pay Scale for the post of Constable will be Rs. 5200-20,200 plus Grade Pay Rs. 2000/- (Now pay matrix level – 3 i.e revised Rs.21,700 – 30,200 as per 7th Central Pay Commission). In addition, the post will carry dearness allowances/Ration Money as admissible from time to time, free accommodation, free uniform, free medical facilities, free leave pass once in a year during leave as admissible under rules in the Force.

6. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

(A) NATIONALITY/CITIZENSHIP

A candidate must be a citizen of India.

(B) EDUCATION QUALIFICATION

The candidate must have passed 10th / matriculation examination or its equivalent from a Board recognized by the Central or State Govt.

(C) AGE LIMIT

Between 18 to 28 years as on 01.08.2016 (by giving 5 years relaxation as a ST candidate)

Note:-

- 1) Candidates should note that only the Date of birth as recorded in the Matriculation/Secondary Examination certificate or an equivalent certificate available on the date of appearing in recruitment test alongwith application will be accepted by the Recruitment Board for determining the age and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.
- 2) The age relaxation available to different category of eligible candidates, for claiming age relaxation as on the date of reckoning:

Category	Age-Relaxation permissible beyond the Upper age limit
ST candidate	23+05 = 28 Years (by giving 5 years relaxation as a ST candidate)
Ex-Service men (ST)	23+05+03 = 31 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on the date of reckoning.

Note :- No PET will be held for Ex-Servicemen. However, they will be required to qualify in written & medical examination.

(F) **GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT MEDICAL PARAMETERS:-** Detailed medical examination will be conducted as per guidelines issued by MHA. Some of the important parameters are as below:-

- (i) The minimum distant vision without correction and without wearing of glasses should be 6/6 of the better eye & upto 6/9 of the worse eye,
- (ii) Further, colour blindness will be a disqualification for the post and if at any stage of their service career, if they are found to be colour blind, they will be boarded out as per SHAPE Policy in vogue.
- (iii) The candidates must not have knocked knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties. They should conform to the medical standards prescribed by the Force and should be declared fit by the Medical Officers of CAPFs. The medical certificate obtained from elsewhere will not be entertained.

- (iv) Medical tests (X-Ray & Laboratory) shall be conducted of all candidates by Medical Officer of CRPF as prescribed in eligibility criteria as per new guidelines.
- (v) Testimonials of the candidates will be checked **at the medical examination stage by the Recruitment Board.**

(G) CONDITION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN

Ex-serviceman means a person, who has served in any rank whether as combatant or non-combatant in regular capacity in Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian union and:-

- (a) Who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension or
- (b) Who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service/circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension or
- (c) Who has been released, otherwise than on his own request from such service as a result of reduction in establishment: or
- (d) Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity and include personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories namely:-
 - (I) Pension holders for continuous (embodied) service.
 - (II) Persons with disability attributable to military service: and
 - (III) Gallantry award winner.
- (e) For recruitment of Ex-servicemen for the post of Constable (General Duty & Tradesman) in CRPF:-
 - (a) Physical Standard : Total relaxation
 - (b) Medical Category : SHAPE-1 (One)
 - (c) Character : Exemplary/Very Good/Good
 - (d) Education : Total relaxation
 - (e) Age Limit : Age concession for Ex-Servicemen will be allowed in accordance with the orders issued by the Govt. of India from time to time and they will be allowed to deduct Military service from their actual age and such resultant age should not exceed the Prescribed age limit by more than three years.

- (f) PET will not be held for Ex-servicemen. However they will be required to qualify in Written, Trade Test and Medical examination as applicable.
- (g) In case of vacancies reserved for Ex-Servicemen, the reserved vacancies remained unfilled due to non-availability of eligible or qualified candidates, the same shall be filled by candidates from “**non-Ex Servicemen category**”.

7. **APPLICATION**

(i) Application form will be submitted by the candidates directly to the Recruitment Board at recruitment centre in prescribed format as per ‘**Appendix-A**’. The candidate applying should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility conditions for the post. Their admission at all the stages of the examination will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If on verification, at any time before or after the written test, Trade Test and medical examination, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility condition, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the board.

(ii) A candidate can apply for post of CT(GD) and CT(Tradesmen) as per eligibility criteria. Further, while opting for CT(Tradesmen), a candidate can opt only one trade amongst the CT(Tradesmen). Separate application be got filled from the candidate if he/she is applying for both posts.

(iii) The written examination of Constable(GD) and Constable(Tradesmen) will be conducted in two shift accordingly to facilitate candidate to appear in written examination.

8. **APPLICATION FEE**

No application fee from any candidate will be charged.

9. **BOARD’S DECISION AND APPEAL PROCEDURE.**

The decision of the Recruitment Board in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), and selection will be final and binding on the candidates.

However, a candidate can appeal against the boards decision as provided for herein after in 11(E).

10. **HOW TO APPLY**

The recruitment will be conducted by special rally system at identified Districts of LWE State at the respective places/location as stated in Para-1. Candidates are required to report to the recruitment centre with a duly filled application form as per proforma attached in **Appendix-A**. The application should be typewritten or neatly hand written on one side of foolscap A4 size plain paper. Application should be accompanied by photocopies of following documents:-

- (a) Two recent passport size photographs (One should be pasted on the application form. The other photograph will bear name and signature of the candidate on the reverse).
- (b) Copies of Matriculation certificate as proof of educational qualification and date of birth.
- (c) A valid "Domicile Certificate/Permanent Residential Certificate" issued by the competent authority so authorized by the concerned State.
- (d) Any other certificate in support of additional qualification.
- (e) Those candidates who wish to claim relaxation on the basis of caste should produce relevant documents as per **Appendix-"B"** in support thereof, viz. caste certificate in respect of candidates belonging to ST from a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar. Those candidates who wish to claim relaxation under the Ex-servicemen category should produce documents in support thereof.
- (f) Candidate should also bring original documents with them in addition to attested copies and should be produced on demand.
- (g) **ST Certificate:-** If a candidate does not produce his/her caste certificate in any format at the time of PST/PET, he/she may not be allowed for further process and straightway rejected due to submission of false information. However, if he/she requested for time to submit his/her caste certificate, he/she may be allowed by giving a firm date to submit his/her caste certificate in last date of PST/PET. On submission of requisite certificate he/she may be assessed for PST/PET. Further, in case ST candidate does not produce caste certificate in other than "prescribed format" repeat (prescribed format) at the time of PST/PET, he/she may be allowed for further process subject to production of requisite certificate in "prescribed format" at the last date of PST/PET by obtaining requisite undertaking. If candidate fails to do so till the last date of PST/PET, his/her candidature may be treated as cancelled.

11. **STAGE-I : SELECTION PROCEDURE**

(1) **REGISTRATION**

On reporting of candidate at Rally Centre, Application will be collected and name will be registered by allotting Roll Numbers on the spot. For accessing to rally ground identity proof i.e. Domicile Certificate, Aadhar No., Pan Card, Voter ID Card and Ration Card etc. could be accepted. The details scrutiny of the eligibility will not be undertaken by the board at the time of PET/PST and candidates prima-facie eligible will be allowed to appear in PET/PST.

STAGE-II : (PST/PET)

(A) HEIGHT BAR TEST

At the very beginning, candidates will be asked to go through the height bar and thereby ineligible candidates with lesser height will get eliminated. (For CT/GD ONLY)

(B) RACE

The candidates who are found eligible on height parameters will undergo PET (race) as per details mentioned at para 6(E) . The race prescribed will be of qualifying nature.

(C) IDENTIFICATION

Those who qualify in the race will be subjected to the modern biometric methods to obviate impersonation by the candidates. The biometric methods should be used at all stages of the recruitment (in the absence of computer based biometric equipments, thumb impression digital photograph and any specific identifying mark in the body may be used).

(D) PHYSICAL STANDARD TEST

Those who are found eligible on Bio-metric identification will be subjected to height, chest and weight measurement. Relaxation in height & chest (as the case may be) will be permissible only on production of requisite certificate. Candidate who do not fulfill the laid down physical standard will be eliminated for participating in the further process. After qualifying in the PST/PET, intimation for appearing in the written test on the fixed date will be given to the candidate on the spot by the recruitment board.

(E) APPEAL

Appeals from candidates who are not satisfied with their physical measurement will be accepted. If candidate is found to be within the prescribed PST standard they will be forwarded to next selection process in continuation. Following officers will act as appellate authority in this regard:-

STAGE-III : CONDUCT OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION ON 06-11-2016

- i) The candidate(s) who qualified in PET/PST shall be allowed to appear in written Examination.
- ii) The written Examination will consist of only non-OMR based objective type multiple choice questions as per details given below :-
- iii) The question paper will be set in Bilingual pattern i.e English & Hindi in Devnagari script.
- iv) The questions relating to basic knowledge of English & Hindi will be set in English and Hindi language respectively and candidate should answer questions relating English language in English and Hindi language in Hindi only.

v) The written examination of Constable (GD) & Constable (Tradesman) will be conducted in two shift as per details given below to facilitate candidate to appear in written examination :-

a) For Constable (GD)	:	1000 to 1200 Hrs.
b) For Constable (Tradesman)	:	1500 to 1700 Hrs.

(A) For the rank of Constable(GD)

Only One Paper carrying Total - 100 Marks of 2 Hours duration with 100 questions objective type multiple choice questions carrying 01 mark each to assess the following :-

- a) General awareness/knowledge.
- b) Knowledge of elementary mathematics
- c) Analytical aptitude.
- d) Ability to observe and distinguish patterns.
- e) Basic knowledge in English/Hindi.

(B) For the rank of Constable(Tradesmen)

Only One Paper carrying Total - 100 Marks consisting two parts, i.e. Part-I-Knowledge expected from Class 10 pass candidates and Part-II relating to knowledge of the trade. The duration of written examination will be two hours as per details given below :-

PART-I (50 Questions of 01 mark each)

- a) General awareness/knowledge.
- b) Knowledge of elementary mathematics
- c) Analytical aptitude.
- d) Ability to observe and distinguish patterns.
- e) Basic knowledge in English/Hindi.

PART-II (50 Questions of 01 mark each)

Questions of this part will also have 50 objective types multiple choice questions carrying 01 mark each, separately for each trade to assess the knowledge of the candidate in respective trade. Candidate applying for a particular trade will be given question paper pertaining to that trade only. **Minimum passing marks for qualifying the written examination for all the posts will be 33%.**

Note :- Questions will be set on SSC pattern in Hindi and English for all posts.

- iii) Question paper will be set **in Hindi & English only**. Accordingly, questions relating to General awareness, General knowledge, knowledge of elementary mathematic, analytical aptitude ability to observe & distinguish patterns & concerned professional trade should be set in Hindi & English respectively.

**STAGE-IV : CONDUCT OF TRADE TEST FOR CONSTABLE
TRADESMAN / TRADESWOMEN**

- a) All the candidates declared pass in written examination will undergo trade test which will be qualifying in nature.
- b) Trade Test/practical assessment to be done in two events as subjective and objective i.e. practical assessment and written skill, which will be qualifying in nature. Out of 50 marks for practical Trade Test, a candidate must secure 20 marks to qualify. The details are as under : –

Note:- Trade Test assessment is to be carried as per prescribed procedure. The oral, practical and experience part will be assessed and the award of marks will be keeping in view of supporting documents and on basis of performance during such assessment. During Trade Test, a candidate will be asked to perform any activity pertaining to that particular trade for which he/she has appeared/applied. The parameters for each trade will be as under :-

i)	Bugler	: Playing of Bugle.
ii)	Cobbler	: Having Knowledge of his Trade. Polishing of Shoes, handling of tools, cutting of leather, repair and stitching of shoes. Making of new shoes.
iii)	Gardener	: Knowledge of Plantation, maintenance of plants, Knowledge of seeds and their seasons, fertilizer and manures.
iv)	Cook	: Cooking of Chapati & Rice /Vegetable /Dal /Sambhar/ Idli etc. cooking of Meat/Fish /Egg/ Kheer.
v)	Water Carrier	:: Washing of utensil, kneading of Atta for making chapattis and cutting of vegetable etc.
vi)	Safai Karmachari	: Sweeping of floors, open area and cleaning of toilets, bathrooms etc.
vii)	Barber	: Handling of tools, hair cutting and shaving.

viii)	Washer man/ Washer- woman	: Washing of clothes, Ironing of Khaki cotton Uniform, woolen and TC Uniform.
ix)	Hair Dresser (Female)/ Barber	: Handling of tools and hair cutting of Mahilas.

STAGE-V :: MEDICAL EXAMINATION.

- i) Only those candidates who have scored above the cut-off marks fixed in written examination will be required to appear in the medical examination. The number of candidates to be declared qualified in written test will be equal to the number of the vacancies, increased by average failure rate during last medical examination determined on the basis of past experience.
- ii) The candidates will be medically examined to assess their physical & medical fitness as prescribed in the eligibility conditions laid down by MHA.
- iii) Medical tests (X-Ray & Laboratory) shall be conducted of all candidates by Medical Officer of CRPF as prescribed in eligibility criteria as per new guidelines.
- iv) The medical officer while carrying out medical examination will declare the candidate "FIT" or "UNFIT". In no case, a candidate will be declared "temporary unfit".
- v) However, candidate declared "medically unfit" may file an appeal/representation within 15 days of rejection by the Medical Officer in prescribed proforma. The appeal panel shall decide their appeal within a period of one month of the date of rejection. If found medically fit by appeal panel, the candidate will be recruited subject to availability of vacancies and subject to his making merit criteria fixed for final selection.
- vi) Declaring a candidate fit in medical examination will not be a guarantee for appointment as final selection is made in order of merit and limited to availability of vacancies in respective categories.
- vii) The testimonial/certificate of the candidate will be checked at the medical examination stage by the Board.

1. APPEAL AGAINST MEDICAL EXAMINATION.

If a candidate is declared "UNFIT" in medical examination, the grounds for rejection/unfitness will be communicated to the candidate by recruiting doctor duly countersigned by PO of the Recruitment Board. The candidate, if not satisfied with the findings of the recruiting doctor, can submit appeal for review medical examination (RME) to the Appellate Authority with a certificate, indicating of error of judgment, of his medical fitness from a Medical Officer of concerned specialist from district hospital and above along with registration no. given by MCI/ State medical council practitioner. The medical certificate or proof will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the Medical Officer concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been declared unfit for service by CRPF recruiting medical board for appointment in CRPF. Appeal will be submitted **within 15 days** from the date of issue of the communication of his/her medical unfitness. The IG, Chhattisgarh Sector, CRPF, Old Hidayatullah National Law University, Near PHQ,

Raipur, Chhattisgarh-492001 will be the Appellate Authority for the purpose. A Medical Officer will be associated as with the Appellate Authority for screening appeals. The candidates whose appeals are accepted by the Appellate Authority shall be directed to appear before Review Medical Board (RMB) giving them specific date, time and venue well in time. The RME of unfit candidates will be conducted by RME Board at notified centre. Medical will be conducted as per existing instructions in vogue.

STAGE –VI : DRAWAL OF FINAL MERIT LIST

- i) After completion of medical examination test, District/category wise merit list in each category namely ST & Ex-servicemen(ST) will be drawn separately on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained in written test by the candidate.
- ii) In case of tie in marks, the merit list will be prepared in the following order:-
 - (a) The tie is resolved by the Board by referring to the total marks in the written examination i.e. a candidate having more marks in the written examination gets preference over the candidate(s) with less marks.
 - (b) If the tie still persists, the candidate older in age gets preference.
 - (c) If the tie still persists, it is finally resolved by referring to the alphabetical order of names i.e. a candidate whose first name begins with the alphabet which comes first in the alphabetical order gets preference.
- iii) Appointment to the candidate will be given only after securing place in merit list and limited to availability of vacancies in respective categories.

12. FINAL SELECTION.
